With modern, efficient electric motors, the new mill will reduce energy consumption for this part of the process by around 30 per cent. It will be fully enclosed in a building 34 metres high, minimising noise and reducing the potential for escape of cement dust.

The project also includes the construction of new cement silos and associated facilities alongside the existing railway line to load trains. At present the rail link is used to bring in coal to fire the kilns. In future, three trains a week will be despatched to Hanson's depots in London, Bristol and Scotland.
