

Penderyn Quarry Residents Nomination/Selection

At the meeting of Penderyn Quarry Liaison Group on 28th January, the vacancy for a Residents' representative was discussed and it was agreed to fill the vacancy and future "mid term" vacancies by co-option via the Penderyn Quarry Liaison Group panel.

In advance of the next RCT Council Term (May 2022) the full selection process will again take place for the three resident positions, with a resident ballot the same day as the Council elections, should there be more than three applications. Those positions would last until the next Council elections with any arising vacancies filled by co-option via the panel as is the case for this vacancy.

Nominations are therefore sought, from Penderyn residents, to fill the one vacant position.

If there is more than one nomination then Penderyn Quarry Liaison Group will select one candidate from the nominations.
