1	APOLOGIES & INTRODUCTIONS See above.
2	MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING Approved: Ron Hampson / Garry Nancarrow
3	MATTERS ARISING Garry Nancarrow: not sure as to the outcome wished for by the Ramblers Association with regards to the possible path through the site. Clearly this is not feasible with an operating site, but there may be a formal diversion requirement through existing rights of way.
4	PLANNING UPDATE (Gary Nancarrow) Planning for improved warehouse for the packed product. This will extend from an existing building

	<p>across an internal site road. This has only just been received in the planning office.</p> <p>Ron Hampson: Why is this needed?</p> <p>David Quick: New truck fleet designs mean there is a requirement for higher vehicles through the warehouse; the existing facility would not allow this to happen and to be loaded safely. The new loading area will improve health and safety for those loading and environment in which they work. This is being funded through a £600K capital expenditure.</p> <p>This will also incorporate moving current outside storage and concrete over an existing grass area. Unfortunately this means the removal of some poplars, however these are coming to end of life span and some have already had to be removed for safety. They will be replaced with a planting scheme with indigenous species on other site areas to increase/preserve the local biodiversity.</p> <p>GN: this is supported by local planning and will provide an appropriate background, but discussions will be undertaken within planning and their tree experts.</p>
5	<p>NRW UPDATE (Stuart Ross)</p> <p>See attached notes:</p> <p>Questions / Matters arising:</p> <p>Joseph Caruana: Noticed a “mineral” odour Saturday afternoon and could see crane movements on site, was this moving cementitious material?</p> <p>Victoria Smith: No, this was lifting men and new cladding panels to complete the re-cladding of the gas conditioning tower. No works being carried out would have led to an odour. Odour complaints are very difficult to track after the fact. A phone call to the Dusty Shift manager as soon as it is detected offers the best chance of solution.</p>
6	<p>PADESWOOD UPDATE (David Quick/VAS)</p> <p>VAS: See attached Report.</p> <p>David Quick gave the meeting an updated forecast on the production plans for Padeswood, including the export of clinker.</p> <p>There will be some engineering work this week to replace blocks around the kiln outlet. The site will then run through to Mid-July, with a 2 week stop. A sluice fitted by FLS, incorrectly in January shut down needs to be replaced.</p>
8	<p>Council Response</p> <p>RH: pleased everything going well. Asked what the current recruitment plans were</p> <p>DQ: 96 head count from a min of 42, with a few vacancies to be filled.</p>

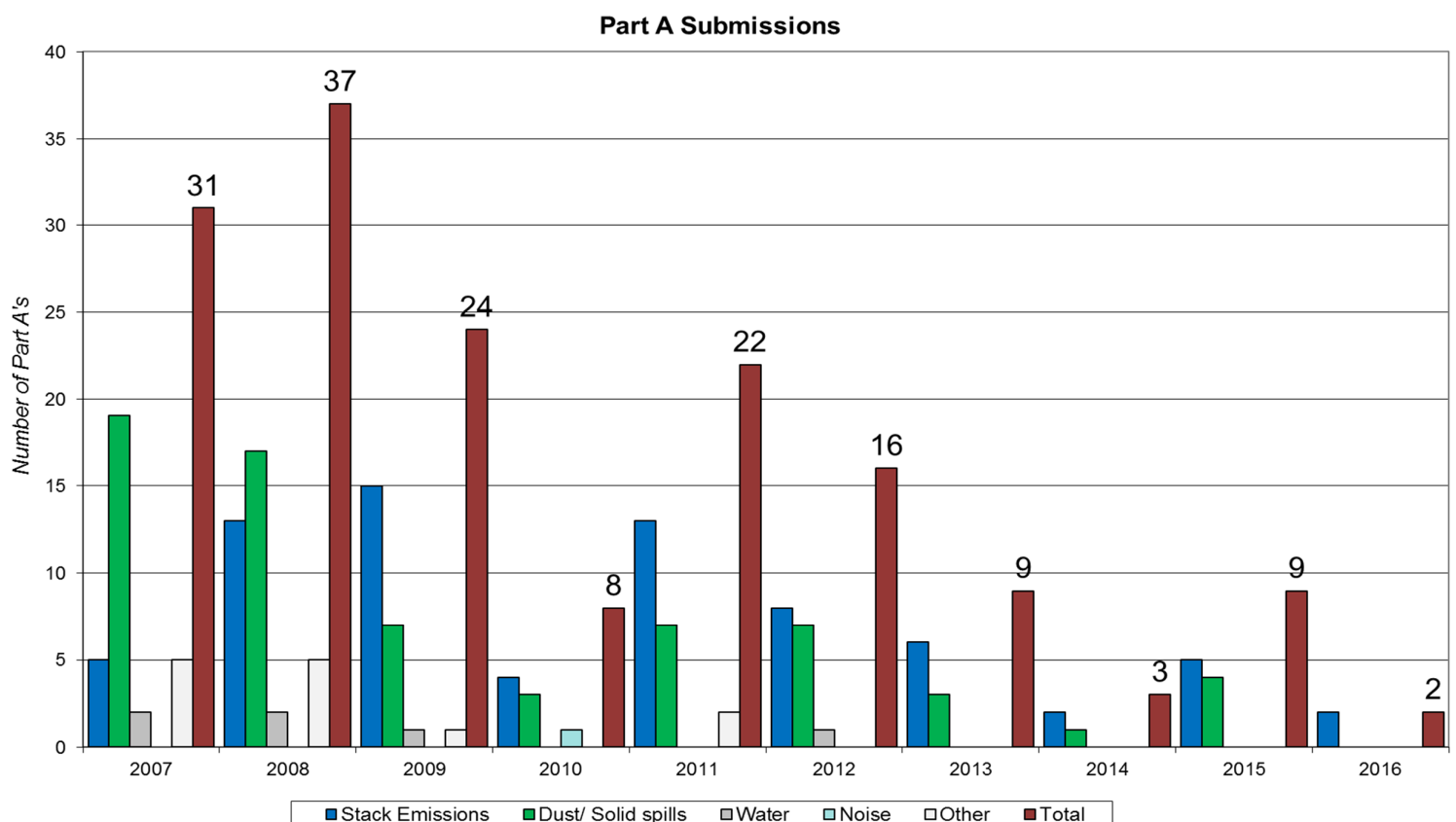
	JC: Nice to see the plan running better environmentally.

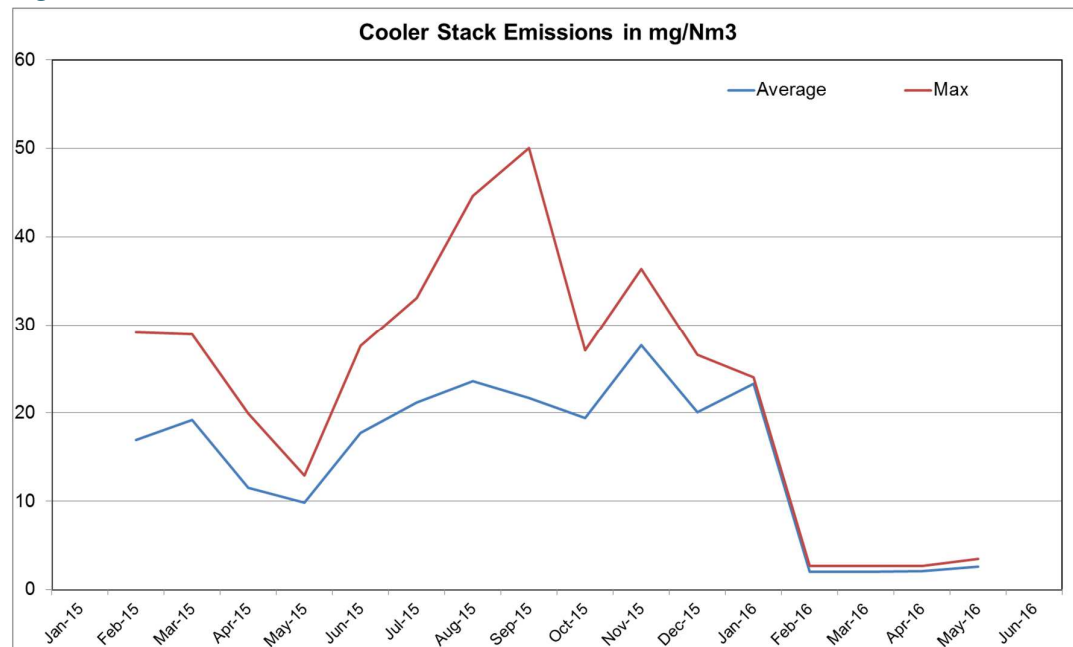
- Permit Breaches 2016. 2 year to date, none since last meeting

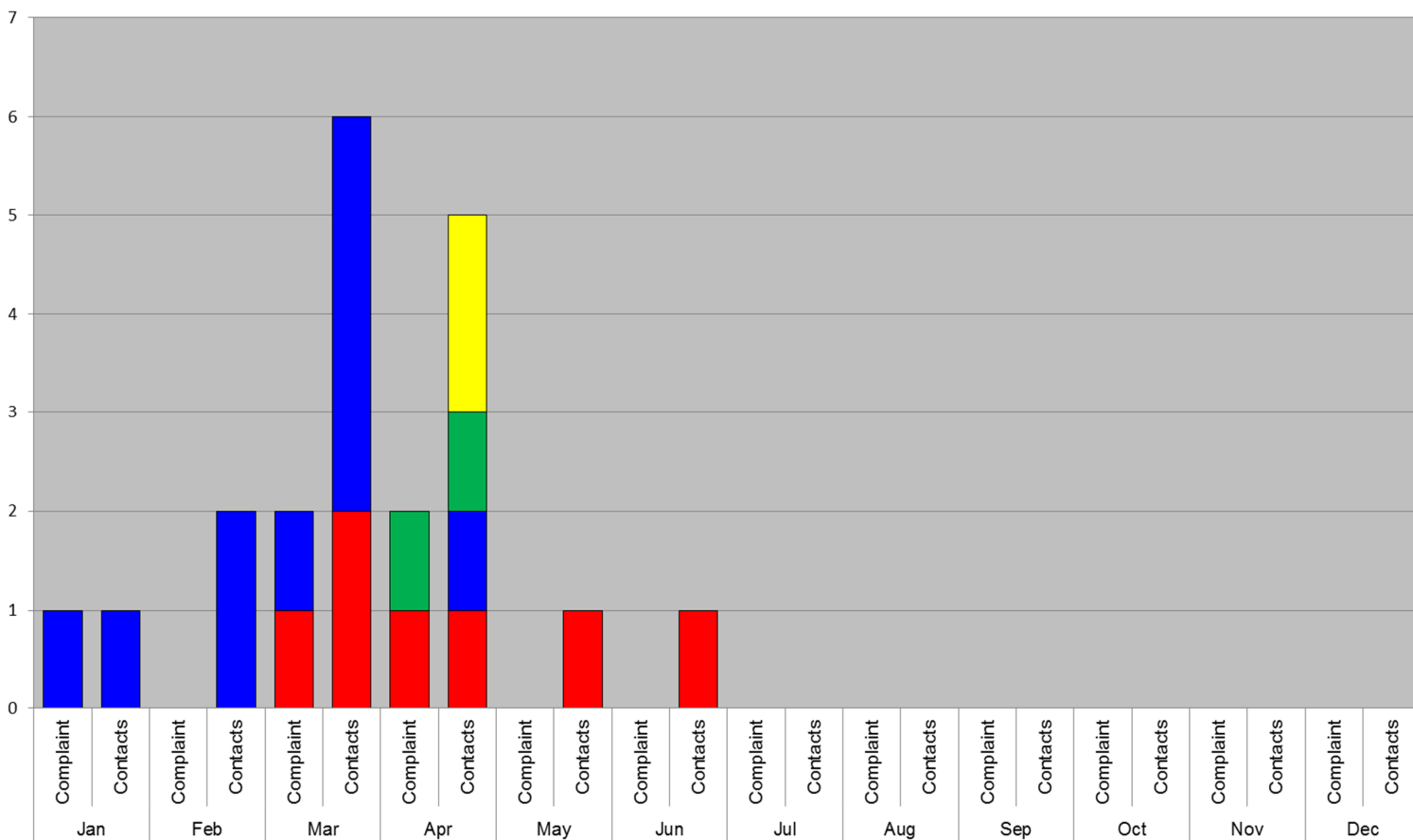
■ Contacts and Complaints:

Local Resident Contacts and Complaints to Castle Cement by Type 2016

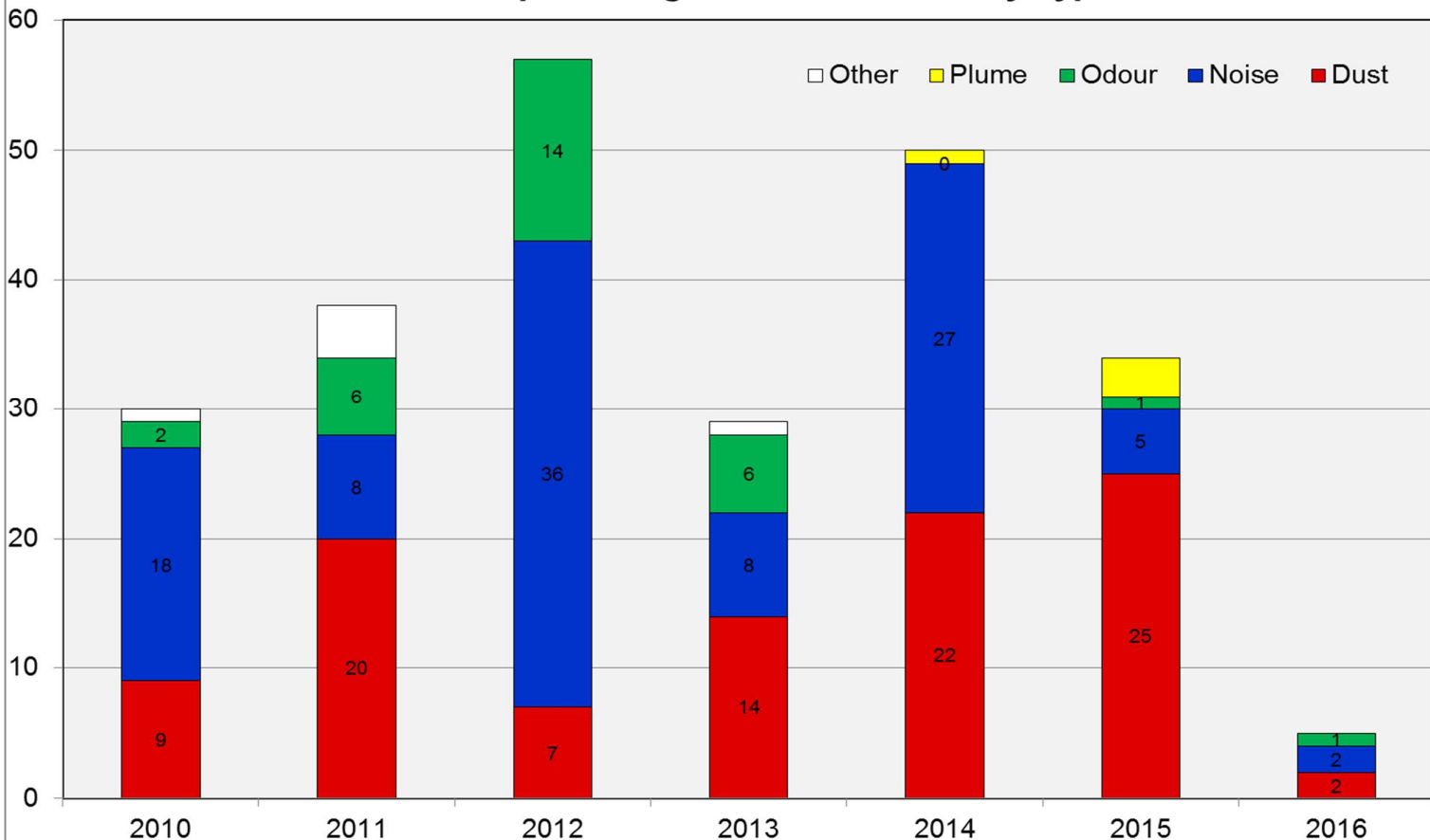
Other Plume Odour Noise Dust
