Tytherington Quarry, Tytherington – Planning Submission

Please find enclosed a consolidated planning submission in respect of Tytherington Quarry, a limestone quarry located to the west of the village of Tytherington, South Gloucestershire. This submission comprises the two following planning applications:

- A Section 73 planning application to vary conditions 1 (duration of permission)¹ and 25 (restoration and aftercare) to the extant principal planning consent NA/IDO/002/A (dated February 2006) for Tytherington quarry; and
- A Section 73 planning application to vary conditions 4 & 5 (approved working scheme), 17 & 18 (overburden and topsoil storage area) to the extant planning consent P93/2645 (dated December 2002) covering the soil store area.

All required documentation is submitted via the Planning Portal, under references: PP-12984596 and PP-13001767.

By way of an overview, this consolidated submission comprises:

- A Planning Supporting Statement: this document relates to both applications/ submissions.
- An Environmental Statement (ES), which also covers both applications and is split as follows:
 - Volume 1 Non-Technical Summary;
 - Volume 2 ES Main Report;
 - Volume 3 Figures; and
 - Volume 4 Appendices.
- A stand-alone Flood Risk Assessment (FRA) (with associated appendix).

In line with Planning Portal policy, all documents have been saved in a format which ensures that no single file size exceeds 10MB. The appropriate planning application fee of £726 (£363 per application) has also been paid online through the Planning Portal system.

¹ Despite the title of this condition, Heidelberg Materials are <u>**not**</u> seeking to change the duration of the permission but rather to amend the condition to reference the approved documents relevant to the permission.
